



Teaching

WHAT? What are we talking about? SO WHAT? Why does it matter to God and to us? NOW WHAT? What should we do about what we just learned?

RECOMMENDED FOR AUGUST



A SERIES RJOSEPH

- God loves everyone the same. Joseph's dreams cause conflict with his brothers (Genesis 37).
- God watches over us. Joseph is taken to Egypt (Genesis 39-41).
- 3 God will make things right. Joseph reunites with his horthers and father reunites with his brothers and father (Genesis 42-45).
- We can obey God above anyone else. The Israelites are oppressed after Joseph's death (Genesis 50-Exodus 1).

A SERIES REXODUS

- We follow God's lead. The plagues on Egypt and Passover (Exodus 7-12).
- God leads us to safety. The Israelites escape from Egypt (Exodus 13-15).
- God will lead us to what we need. The Israelites begin their journey in the wildemess (Exodus 15-16).

RECOMMENDED FOR OCTOBER



- We can choose to be thankful. God provides water from a rock (Exodus 17).
- We can love God and others. God gives the Ten Commandments (Exodus 20).
- We can go to God when we're lost. The
- worship of a golden calf (Exodus 32). We can go to God when we need rest.






The Great Commission

Make Every Interaction Count

- Build Relationships with kids- without a relationship it's impossible to influence a kid's faith in a significant way.
- Build Relationships with Others- Help kids build relationships with others in their community.
- Show up consistently- Kids feel safe and loved when they are connected to a familiar trusted adult.
