We are always adding to this team, if you're interested talk to Lindsay Hodges.





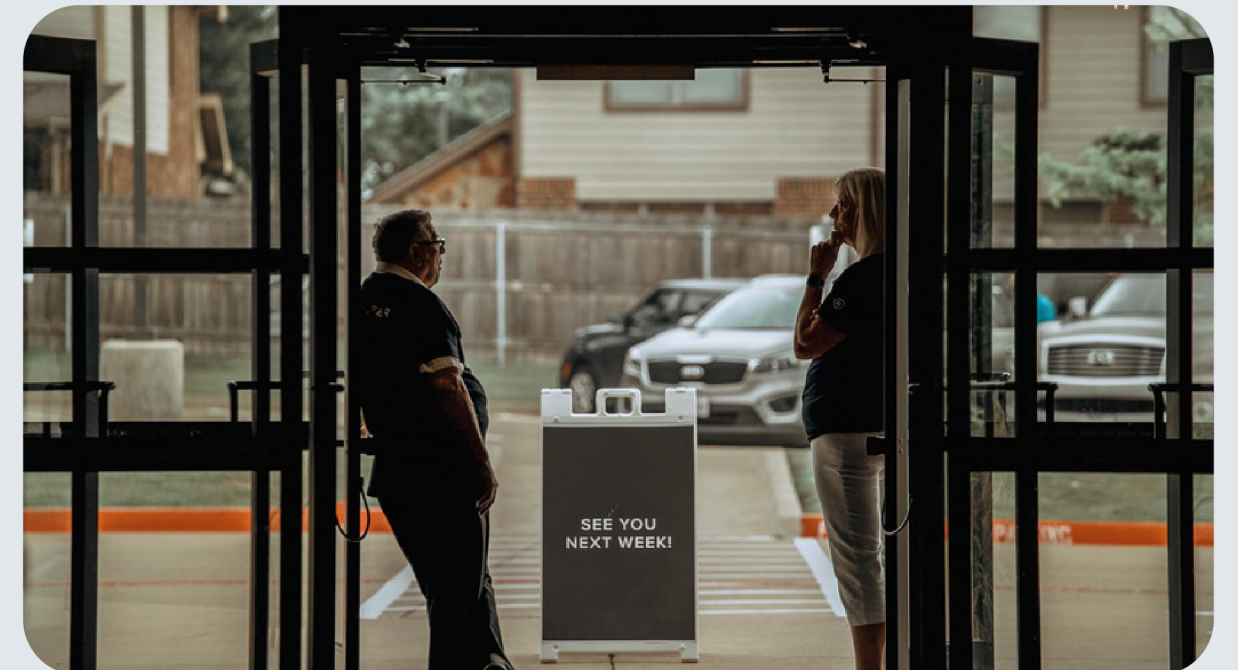
Train the People

Practical Implementation for Hillside





Communication

Structure in place from Leadership Staff to Volunteers via radios on Sundays and Wednesdays.

Trained to follow a safety protocol if an emergency situation unfolds.



Facility Modification

Facilities Team and volunteers have spent many hours putting secure locks on all Children's and Student Building doors.

We have also added 'go-bags' to all of our Children's classrooms for emergency situations.





Emergency Phone

This phone number is posted around campus for anyone to use. The staff member in charge on Sundays and Wednesdays carries this phone with them at all times.



Medical Response Team

In the back left of the Sanctuary (with the read seat covers) are seated qualified professionals to assist in minor emergencies. Contact a staff or E&E member and they will help contact them. They also wear bright red lanyards. Can't miss them!
